Thanx to the hard work of Paul Pope and Rey Santos, the rosters and pre and post-tests that accompany the Something's Fishy, Wildlife Success Stories/Endangered Species, City Critters and White-tailed Deer school enrichment modules are now in a scannable format (see attached). What this means is that there is no longer any need for pre/post-test data to be entered by hand on the website by Ceas or their staffs. Data summary following analyses will still be available to all users on the same website at the county, district and state level by module type. This is a huge step forward after the Extension Data Center-EIT, (which formerly handled data entry) was dis-banded several years ago. My records indicate that we have a total of some 25 duplicates of these 4 module scenarios scattered across the state. My intent with this mass e-mailing is to get these new forms into the hands of module coordinators so the student roster sheets/test copies in the various lessons can be updated before the 2009-10 school year begins. Hopefully, this streamlining of data entry via Paul Pope's shop will encourage more use of the modules we have available.
